Woodsford Square is an iconic and award-winning development of town houses designed by architects Fry, Drew and Partners in the late 1960s.

Located towards the northern end of the prestigious Addison Road, close to the bars and café culture of Holland Park Avenue and High Street Kensington and the first-class shopping at Westfield. There are excellent local schools in the public and private sectors, and the house is within easy walking distance of the open spaces of Holland Park. Woodsford Square is also perfectly situated for transport links, with easy access out of London to Heathrow Airport and the west via the M4.
