The property is held on a 150 year lease from the 25 December 1964. The annual ground rent is £10 and the annual service charge is £2,750. This includes the heating, hot water, contribution towards the buildings insurance, communal cleaning and management fees. The building is managed by Camden.

The property has gas central heating via a communal heating system and fibre broadband. The building is serviced by electricity, mains water and sewerage and mobile phone coverage is available. There is street CPZ parking available.





